

There are already 18 of these distinctive green signs bearing the Town Council coat of arms which can be seen on buildings throughout Horwich as part of the civic trail which has created a permanent and appropriate acknowledgment of the town's rich history. The Town Council will be adding to these in 2024, chosen from a list of sites nominated by the public. The purpose of a civic plaque is to acknowledge that the building has either an historical significance or an association with a prominent Horwich resident. *Please bear in mind that the plaque will need to be fixed to an existing building and must be clearly seen from the road.*
